In science, we will be exploring and identifying common plants and trees in the garden and in the wild as well as sorting deciduous and evergreen leaves. We will also be monitoring and keeping a diary of our vegetables and having a competition to who can grow the biggest beanstalk as part of our home learning project!

Our literacy this term will focus on old fashioned poems or nursery rhymes such as 'Mary Mary quite contrary' and 'Polly put the kettle on' as well as traditional tales like Jack and The Beanstalk.
