Term 3 – Into the Gallery

Grab your paintbrushes and aprons, it's going to get messy in Acorns!

This term we are going to be looking at a range of artists and artwork, discussing what we notice, what we like and how they make us feel. We will be thinking about how art has changed over the years in History and looking at the work of Kandinsky, Mondrian, Matisse and Thompson and seeing where they lived in our Geography lessons. We will be creating our own masterpieces in Art, seeing if we can replicate the techniques used by the artists we will be looking at, ready for the Acorns Gallery at the end of term!

We will continue to improve our writing skills by using artwork as stimulus to see if we can write about how the artwork makes us feel. During phonics we will continue with our bug club, adding to our repertoire of known phonemes and graphemes and using them to help us with our reading and writing! We will continue to focus on addition and subtraction in mathematics this term, seeing if we can solve some mathematical problems using our mathematician skills. Additionally, we will also be exploring shape, and adding to our understanding of number!

We will continue our Jigsaw journey in PSHE, thinking about Dreams and Goals and what we can do to achieve them. Acorns will be investigating everyday materials in Science and seeing if we can identify them and their properties using our scientific skills. Lastly, in RE we will be answering the question 'What is the good news Jesus brings?' and thinking about Jesus' teachings and how that helps Christians to know how they should live.
