

During Term 2, we are continuing our 1920s and 1930s topic, this will involve extensive reading of various mystery stories. In Mathematics, the children will be solving word problems and will really have to look for clues and unlock secret codes!

We are continuing to read *The Body in the Library* by Agatha Christie and will be developing an understanding of how character traits can subtly appear in storytelling. What makes a good detective and how might this be portrayed when they are solving a mystery?

In RE, we are exploring the question 'Was Jesus the Messiah?' investigating stories and prophecies in the Bible to gain evidence and develop our own personal responses.

In Music, the children will be writing and performing their own compositions. They will be continuing to use glockenspiels in lessons.
