

The Super Sycamores have been fully immersed in the rainforests of the world. We have found out: where rainforests can be found; what can be found there; the weather conditions and why they are so important to the whole planet. We have also found out the different habitats that can be found between the different layers of the forests.

This term our Big Question is 'Where did the Mayans go?' We are going to be historians exploring the ancient civilisation of the Mayans; finding out what was different about their beliefs and what was surprising about Mayan's cities.

Last term our maths was all about numbers in the number system. We have been reading, writing, counting and ordering large digit numbers, as well as knowing the value of the digit. This term we will use our place value knowledge, to move on to addition, subtraction, division and multiplication; breaking down the different skills needed to be successful and to be able to solve multi-step problems.

In English we will be using some Mayan Myths to influence our writing as well as getting technical with our grammar and punctuation; answering questions like: What is a sentence? What are the different parts of a sentence? What are the different jobs of a sentence? Every day we will be practising our spellings and handwriting skills. Then on Friday mornings we have a spelling/English fluency quiz.

During our science lessons we have been investigating how sound works, how it travels and how we hear and how we don't hear. This term we will be learning about how light travels and how we see. We will answer our Big Question; 'What is the same and different about light and sound?'
