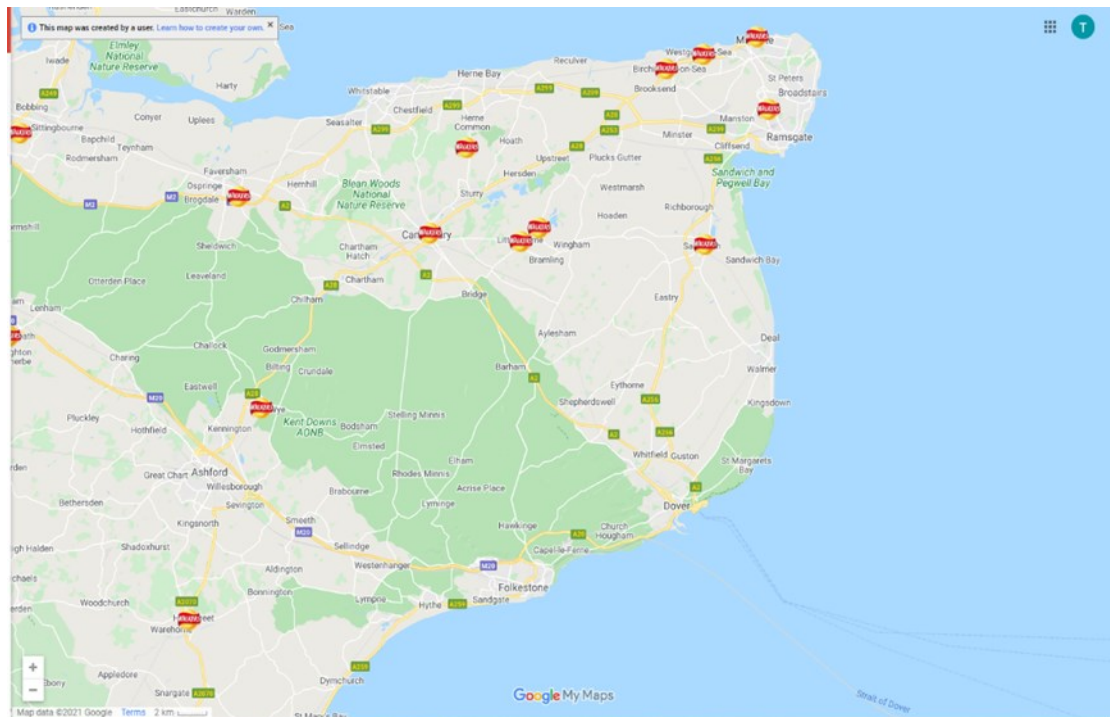

TerraCycle Crisp Snack Packet Recycling

We are really sorry to announce but we have decided it is no longer viable to continue collecting Walkers/KP Crisps and snack packets as the weight needed to send has been raised to 8kg in a maximum of 2 boxes and due to the lightness of individual packets we had no suitable boxes to keep sending them off and the last two consignments have not gained the school any points on their recycling scheme because the packages were too light.



These new rules do seem to have affected the number of local collection centres as many collection sites have also decided to opt out of the scheme.
