Make Time for Music in Schools

Learning an instrument is fun and gives hours of pleasure. Skills such as confidence, self reliance and commitment all come through learning to play an instrument. It is recognised that children who develop musical skills perform better in the rest of their school work.

We can offer tuition on clarinet, flute, brass, guitar, keyboard, drumkit, cello and violin. Beginners will normally start in small groups, as pupils enjoy working together in the early stages.

As pupils progress, they may prefer to learn in a group of 2 or individually and these options are available on the teacher's advice.

We encourage our pupils to share their experience by performing to their class and in school concerts.

Lessons will normally be during the school day, but we sometimes arrange lessons just after school.

Tuition Fees for each term of 10 lessons

Make Time for Music pupils can take advantage of a rent/buy scheme for wind instruments with Ackerman Music. Please ring the Make Time for Music office for more information.

Stentor Violins can also be bought in 4 quarterly payments of £24.50.

Although guitars and keyboards are not available under the rent/buy scheme, we have negotiated discounts for our pupils at several local music shops.
